# WindBlow Inc. Introduces NuHUB: An Integrated Agro-Processing and Circular-Economy Hub for St. Vincent and the Grenadines

**Belmont, St. Vincent and the Grenadines - 2026/06/12.** WindBlow Inc. today announced NuHUB, the WindBlow Integrated Agro-Processing & Circular-Economy Hub, a proposed agro-processing platform designed to help move more locally grown crops into higher-value SVG-made products while reducing waste through circular-economy use of byproducts.

NuHUB is being positioned as a national food-security and value-creation engine that can support farmers, buyers, technical partners, development institutions and investors. The hub is intended to process root crops, fruits, ginger, turmeric, cacao and other agricultural products into market-ready goods such as fruit pulps, chips, flours, sauces, dried spices, cacao products, beverages, teas and other packaged foods.

The circular-economy model is central to the concept. Byproducts such as peels, seeds, shells and other organic streams are intended to be repurposed into useful inputs, including compost, animal feed, organic fertilizer inputs and future renewable-energy pathways where technically and commercially feasible.

"NuHUB is about keeping more value in St. Vincent and the Grenadines," said Wesley V. Mofford of WindBlow Inc. "Instead of only exporting or selling raw materials, we want to build a system that gives farmers stronger markets, gives buyers consistent products, creates jobs and uses what would normally be waste as part of a circular production model."

## Current Stage

The project is currently in the partnership and financing stage. Final engineering, permit applications, construction activities and operations will proceed only after appropriate financing, technical work and regulatory approvals are secured.

## Planned Focus Areas

<b>Farmer Supply</b>	Crop planning, aggregation, quality standards and farmer market access.
<b>Processing</b>	Washing, grading, pulping, drying, packaging, storage and product development.
<b>Products</b>	Fruit pulps, root crop chips, flours, sauces, spices, cacao products, beverages and packaged foods.

<b>Circular Use</b>	Byproduct recovery for compost, animal feed, bio-inputs and future renewable-energy pathways.
<b>Markets</b>	Hospitality, retail, institutional buyers, local consumers and export channels.
